UIP (Unified Improvement Plan)

- Focus on Math Fluency (carried over from last year, hoping to continue growth and ensure we are still stressing the importance of math fact fluency)
- Aligned Literacy-
 - Specific Goals- CMAS ELA Average of 70% or above, increase the average high growth on CMAS for our school from 50% to 55%
- Questions
