What is it?

The Reflections program presents a yearly theme and welcomes student submissions in various mediums. At Prospect Valley, we are accepting visual art, photography and literature entries. The theme for 2022 is "Show Your Voice".

Who can enter the contest?

YOU can!...all PV students are invited to participate.

What can I submit?

Visual arts created in any medium, photography, or written expression including fiction, non-fiction, and poetry. **You can only enter one submission per category.**

-Literature must be 2,000 words or less

-No entries can exceed 24" x 30"

-Photographs must be larger than 3" x 5" and can not exceed 8" x 10".

What if I don't have supplies or space to work on it at home? Or, what if I just want a little guidance or support?

We will have 2 open studio times after school in the art room: Monday, Oct. 17th & Thurs. October 27th, from 2:45-4:30.

Tuesday, Nov. 8th

Where do I turn in my work?

Mrs. Hammer will have a drop box in the art room. **Your entry must include an Entry Form signed by a parent.** Entry forms are available in the art room and office.

Then what?

Submissions will be displayed in the school, and a panel of judges will make selections for the winners. Winners will be announced on November 11th! There will be winners selected from K-2nd grade and from 3rd-5th grade in each of the three categories of visual art, photography and literature. If your work is selected, it will be entered into the district wide show with a reception at Red Rocks Community College on Dec. 16th. District winners will move on to National.
